

Settings overprint for Adobe Reader/DC/Professional

Windows:

1. Under the tab „Edit“, select the text field „Preferences“.
2. In the opened window select the text box „Page Display“.
3. Set the overprint view to „Always“.
4. Confirm with ok.
5. The design is now visible.

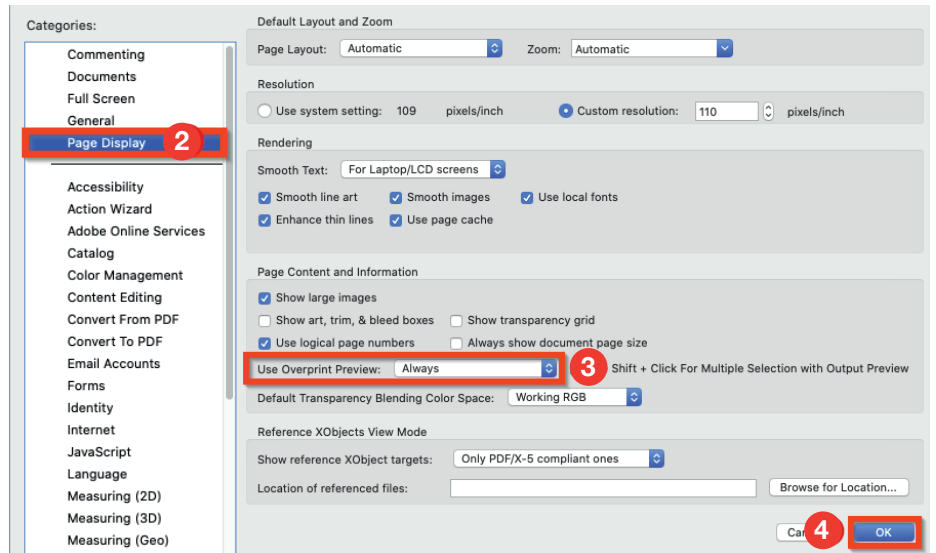
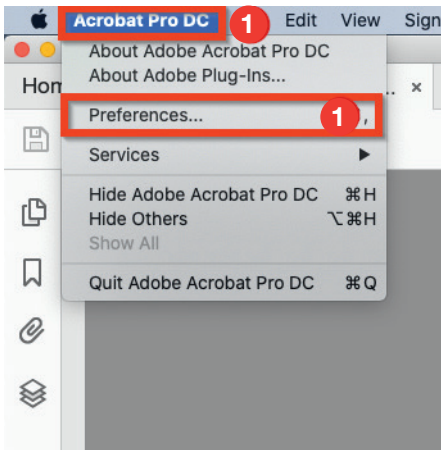
